FUNDING AND FEES EFFECTIVE FROM JANUARY 2011

BIS receives Commonwealth and State Funding in the form of a subsidy for each child attending the school. Fees are necessary to cover operating expenses and will be invoiced in the following categories:

APPLICATION FOR ENROLMENT

Applications for enrolment are considered on receipt of a completed Application Form and payment of an Application Fee of \$105.00 for each child (incl. GST). This is a non-refundable fee.

BOND

The bond (one term's fees) must be paid when enrolment is accepted prior to your child starting school.

ONCE YEARLY COSTS

There is an Accident Insurance Fee of \$15.00 per child and an Association Membership Fee of \$16.00 (plus gst) charged annually. These costs must be paid in the first fee payments for the school each year.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- Fees can be paid as a lump sum, or via a payment plan.

* Payment schedules changes may be lodged with the Administrator in the office who will notify the Treasurer and update your family file. However, changes to payment plans cannot be made with the Administrator if this will bring your account into arrears. These requests must be lodged directly with the BIS Treasurer in writing.

- An early payment discount of \$25.00 per student is given provided all tuition fees and stationery levies are paid by the 2nd week of term.
- Payment methods include banking transfer, cheque or cash.
- Written requests for assistance in cases of financial hardship can be submit to the Treasurer for consideration by the Financial Sub-Committee.
- The school will issue monthly account statements in the first week of every month to each family.
- A statement will be issued in the final week of each term and it is anticipated that each family will have their account up to date by the second week of the new term in order to maintain continuity of their enrolment. If this is not possible the BIS Treasurer must be notified in writing.
